Session Overview

Organisation

This session is organised by a regional committee of EYP France, in Provence Alpes Côte d'Azur, France. It will last 5 days and gather up to 160 participants. Ten high schools will each send ten delegates, with a teacher, who will then be divided into ten committees.

A jury will select a school for a European forum.

Our regional committee hosted six French Sessions since beginning 2009 (including two National Sessions), and will organise this session two months after the last regional session.

Head Organisers of this session are **Léa Le Coq** and **Dalva Barrère**.

President of the session will be **Katarina Warg** from EYP-Sweden.

Participation fee

There is no participation fee for officials. We provide all accommodation, food, transports and all other session-related costs, from your arrival to your departure. Travel costs to and from the session are at your own expense, though.

Accommodation will be at the boarding school of the international high school. Each bedroom is made for 4 people; shower and bathroom in every room.

Teambuilding and Committee Work will take place at the high school and GA will be in Aix-en-Provence.
